

Group 4 Unbadged Competition Rules 2026

Open to all Bowlers who are unbadged on 1st May of each year

1. All Rounds to be played by date shown unless agreed by the Competition Secretary.
The Challenger is required to make contact with their Opponent at the start of each round and in the spirit of the game agree a date for the game to be played to allow the smooth running of the competition to continue
2. The winner of each round shall send the result within 24 hours after the game is played to the Competition Secretary Alan Warner either by what's App/Tex on 07752 363885 or by email to alan_c_warner@yahoo.co.uk clearly stating result and a photo of the score card (please do not phone results through)
3. If a game is given away it will be the responsibility of the player/club going through to adhere to rule 2
4. Semi Finals will be played on a **NEUTRAL GREEN** (except the Colin Morton Triples) and to be booked by the Challenger who must also supply a marker if a singles game , if however the competitors are from the same club they can choose to play it on their own green
5. Dress Code for **Finals Day on Saturday 19th September** at Kings Chase bowls Club will be ***Club Shirt White Shorts /Trousers or Club Colours*** in the Pairs/Triples/Fours ALL players will be required to be dressed the same
6. Champion Of Champions Open to Badged Bowlers (4 wood singles first to 21 wins)
7. Unbadged Singles (4 wood singles first to 21 wins)
8. Unbadged 2Wood Pairs (2 woods each player . Played over 21 ends . Extra end to be played if all level after 21 ends
The two players taking part in the first game shall constitute the pair and shall normally play together throughout the competition . One additional (and the same) player may, however, be used as a substitute at any time provided he has not already played in the competition. He may play in any position.
9. Unbadged Colin Morton Triples (***THIS IS A CLUB ENTRY COMPETITION***)
This is a home and away fixture based on the same rules as the county double fours
The home team in the draw shall be the challengers , in all rounds at the challengers home venue a extra end will be played the score on the extra end shall only apply if the aggregate score is level after 18 ends on each rink that have been completed home and away
Once the Challengers have set a date and time for this Competition , will they please inform the Competition Secretary , who will inform the group 4 selectors , with a view of attending the match for possible players to be considered for a Ashford Cup Trail
ON FINALS DAY , BEFORE THE DRAW FOR RINK AND OPPOSITION IS MADE, ONE OF THE RINK NUMBERS SHALL BE DRAWN TO PLAY THE EXTRA END

THE EXTRA END WILL NOT BE PLAYED UNTIL BOTH RINKS HAVE COMPLETED THE REQUIRED 18 ENDS.IF THE AGGREGATE SCORE IS LEVEL THE EXTRA END MUST THEN BE PLAYED AND APPLIED.
10. Unbadged Fours (2 woods each player . Played over 21 ends . Extra end to be played if all level after 21 ends)
The four players taking part in the first game shall constitute the team and shall normally play together throughout the competition. One additional (and the same) player may, however, be used as a substitute at any time provided he has not already played in the competition. He may play in any position.
